SB 18-038 Reclaimed Water Use on Industrial hemp

Concerning the allowable uses of reclaimed domestic wastewater, and, in connection therewith, allowing reclaimed domestic wastewater to be used for industrial hemp cultivation and making an appropriation.

SB 18-205 Industrial Hemp Designation Agricultural Product

Concerning the regulation of industrial hemp as an agricultural product, and, in connection therewith, identifying the unprocessed seeds of industrial hemp as a commodity under the "Commodity Handler Act" and industrial hemp as a farm product under the "Farm Products Act".

SB 18-235 Colorado Industrial Hemp Research and Development Authority

Concerning the creation of the Colorado industrial hemp research and development authority.

HB 18-1295 Hemp Products Deemed Not Adulterated Or Misbranded

Concerning modifications to the "Colorado Food and Drug Act" to allow products containing industrial hemp, and, in connection therewith, establishing that products containing industrial hemp are not adulterated or misbranded by virtue of containing industrial hemp.

SB 17-117 Recognize Indus Hemp Ag Product for Ag Water Right

Person will conditional or absolute water right decreed for agricultural use may use water subject to water right for growth or cultivation of industrial hemp, if registered by Dept. AG to cultivate Industrial Hemp.

SB 14-184 Oversight of the Industrial Hemp Program

Removes the growing limitations for registered persons growing industrial hemp for research and development purposes. Requires the department to test 80% of the registered hemp crop. State accredited research institutions are exempted from the testing requirement. This bill also establishes a grant program for higher ed research and allows a person to process, sell, and distribute hemp cultivated by a registered person. Finally the bill creates an industrial hemp committee to contribute oversight of hemp.

SB 13-241 Industrial Hemp Growers Registration DOA

Repeals the industrial hemp remediation pilot program established by HB 12-1099 and replaces it with the industrial hemp committee. The program is repealed upon enactment of a federal regulatory system.
